Luci has been a member of the Manchester Artist Association since 1996. She has attended classes at the New Hampshire Institute of Art and has studied under the tutelage of a number of local artists. Her preferred mediums are oils and pastels.

Luci's work has been recognized over the years with a number of awards and ribbons. She placed second in the 2005 NH American Mother's Inc. Cultural Arts Competition. She was awarded First Place, Best in Show for her pastel piece at the 2008 Sidewalk Art Festival in Portland, ME. Also in 2008, Families First Seacoast selected her artwork for the 2009 Artists of the Seacoast Calendar. She won 1st place at the 2008 and 3rd place at the 2010 Littleton NH art shows. Her work has been exhibited at the Nuance Gallery in Windsor, VT and locally at TD BankNorth, Citizen's Bank, MAA Gallery, the Bedford Library, and The Children's Museum in Portsmouth. During May, 2007, she was accepted and exhibited her work at the Robert L. Levy Gallery in Portsmouth. In 2013, an image of one of her paintings was published in a book of short stories called "The Art of Motherhood".

Luci's primary goal is to achieve a sense of realism in her composition by paying close attention to detail. Landscapes, still life, seascapes, and portraits define her work, but her inspiration lies in an appreciation in the natural beauty of the world's palette.

Luci and her husband Norm are longtime residents of Bedford, New Hampshire and have two children and four grandchildren.
