PARKS & RECREATION DEPARTMENT TENNIS COURT USE POLICIES AND REGULATIONS



The Town of Bedford Parks & Recreation Department handles all reservations for Town tennis courts.

TENNIS COURT FACILITIES

- County Road Courts {4 lighted courts 2 non-lighted courts}
- Legacy Park Courts {3 non-lighted courts}

TENNIS COURT USAGE AND RESERVATION PROCESS

- Residents <u>may</u> make a tennis court reservation for recreational purposes by downloading a reservation form off the website: <u>www.bedfordnh.org</u> and/or <u>www.BedfordRecOnline.com</u> if they wish to reserve a specific time <u>Reservations for residents for recreational purposes are FREE.</u>
- Residents wishing to use the tennis courts for recreational purposes do not need a reservation, however use of the courts available is on a first-come-first serve basis.
- Non-Residents and/or "for profit" instructors (both resident and non-resident) MUST obtain a permit by downloading a reservation form off the website: www.bedfordnh.org and/or www.bedfordnh.org and www.bedfordnh.org are paid prior to court use. Permits must be on display when reserving the court(s).

TENNIS COURT RESERVATION PRIORITY

- 1. Town and School Activities
- 2. Youth Town Leagues/Teams (*membership not based on players ability)
- 3. Adult Town League/Teams 90% residency
- 4. Adult Town League/Teams 80% residency/employment
- 5. Individual residents and/or Town Organizations (non-profit)
- 6. Individual residents and/or Town Organizations (for-profit)

TENNIS COURT FEES

- \$20 for ninety minutes per court without use of lights
- \$40 for ninety minutes per court with use of lights

TENNIS COURT PROCEDURES

- The basic rule of tennis etiquette, as governed by the USTA Tennis Association, should be observed at all times by players and spectators; i.e. waiting to retrieve balls that roll into or behind another court until other players have completed their point; refrain from loud talking/yelling in the court area if others are playing, etc.
- Courtesy is asked of all players. There will be a maximum of ninety minutes playtime when Bedford Town residents are waiting for the court.

- Children must not be allowed to run around the tennis courts unattended.
- Use of the tennis courts shall at all time be subject to control of the Parks & Recreation staff, who shall determine the suitability of the courts for play.
- Proper attire is required! All players must wear tennis shoes or gym shoes. Street shoes and sandals are not allowed.
- No bicycles, tricycles, skateboards, rollerblades, roller skates, scooters, or pets are allowed on the tennis courts.
- No canned beverages or glass containers are allowed inside the fenced court area.
- The tennis courts may be closed at any time due to safety reasons, necessary repairs or maintenance.
- Consistent with Parks Ordinance 25-2, Section 25-2-2 (d), drinking of alcoholic beverages in Town parks/facilities is strictly forbidden, unless the individual is a member of a group/league that has been issued a permit by the Police Department and the Parks & Recreation Department in accordance with the requirements set forth by the Town to obtain such approval.

TENNIS COURT MATCHES, LEAGUES, TOURNAMENTS & PRIVATE INSTRUCTORS

- All game schedules and tournament schedules must be submitted according to the Parks & Recreation Field/Facility Use Policy Guidelines and approved by the Parks & Recreation Department and permits displayed.
- All leagues, tournaments and private instructors using the Town of Bedford Parks & Recreation Tennis Courts must submit a Certificate of Insurance naming the Town as an additional insured and must be on file with the Parks & Recreation Department. (The insurance policy must provide for general liability coverage with limits no less than \$1,000,000 per occurrence and \$2,000,000 aggregate for personal injury, bodily injury and property damage). The courts will not be reserved until proof of insurance is received by the Parks & Recreation Department.
- Non-compliance with the Parks & Recreation Department Tennis Court Policy will result in denial of tennis court usage.
